

Community Wells Operating Days and Hours

The Community Wells are not required by the By-Laws or Covenants, they are provided as a free service to the Wild Horse Land owners. Their primary purpose is to provide water for our Fire Department. They are also there so that landowners will not have to haul in water while they drill their own well or are camping for a weekend. They do provide a resource for those owners that have drilled a well which is very slow producing or is dry. These wells are paid for and maintained with the yearly landowners dues.

Usage of the Community wells are being abused by non landowners taking water, by landowners who are not current with their dues taking water and by overuse by landowners and non landowners. In order to protect this precious resource, limits to the amount of water will be established and operating hours will be limited. The wells will not function or operate beyond these limits shown below:

Buck	Mon, Wed, Fri, Sat, Sun 8 AM to 6 PM	250 Gallons
Fire Station	Tues, Thur, Fri, Sat, Sun 8 AM to 6 PM	250 Gallons
Phase III	Wed and Sat 8 AM to 8 PM ✓	400 Gallons

A timer will shut off the well after specified gallons have been pumped and will stay off for 1 hour at the Buck and Fire Station Wells and 2 hours at the phase III Well. The combinations at the community wells will be changed and will not be given to landowners who are not current with their dues. These changes to our well operations, approved by the WildHorse Landowners Board of Directors, will go into effect 1 April 2017. Any landowner found to be giving out faucet padlock combinations to individuals not entitled to our water will lose their rights to water.
